## OREGON LAW: In Violation of Federal/State Laws

The State of Oregon has violated state and federal laws. Parents' Rights in Education has reason to believe Oregon Department of Education and Oregon Health Authority have committed Institutional Betrayal, Participatory Child Abuse, Child Endangerment, and Child Exploitation. Shall the state have unfettered access to minors, influencing health decisions and behavior?

### OREGON LAW SUPPORTS “MINOR RIGHTS” OVER PARENTS ORS 109.640, 109.675, 109.610

- ✓ Oregon legislators passed laws violating U.S. Code and CFRs: ...Parental Rights to “guide the education, moral standards, religious beliefs and elements of good citizenship of their children”. ORS 336.035(2)
- ✓ Oregon legislators passed laws violating two Supreme court decisions upholding parental rights:
  - Wisconsin vs. Yoder [1972] ... “The children are not the mere creatures of the state.”
  - Pierce vs. Society of Sisters, 1925—Oregon
- ✓ Minor Rights to Access Health Care, ORS 109.640, 109.675, 109.610, is used in School Based Health Clinics to supersede parental legal rights to guide the education, moral standards, and religious beliefs of their children.
- ✓ ‘Conversion Therapy’ illegal for minors. It is illegal for parents/guardians to seek counseling for minor children to help them with sexual orientation confusion or gender dysphoria, thus preventing a child from the health and safety dangers most commonly associated with this confusion. Oregon HB 2307 (2015) Amended ORS 675.300

### INFORMED CONSENT ORS 677.097

- ✓ Without knowledge or consent of their parents, minors within the jurisdiction of the school district, may receive medical and/or mental health treatment.
- ✓ Minors do not have the developmental maturity to understand the consequences of mental or medical treatments in order to give 'Informed Consent'.
- ✓ The Oregon HERC (Health Evidence Review Commission), an unelected, unaccountable committee appointed by Governor John Kitzhaber, voted 8-2 to allow children as young as 15 yrs. to undergo transgender conditioning, including hormone replacement and genital mutilation without regard for the possible consequences which can include lung damage, heart damage, sterilization, cancer, drug abuse, depression, suicide.





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## OREGON LAW ALLOWS OBSCENE MATERIAL FOR MINORS

- ✓ Oregon's Obscenity Exemption Law allows schools free reign when offering controversial materials to students. ORS 167.087
- ✓ It's Perfectly Normal, by Robie H. Harris & Michael Emberley
  - Book made available to children as young as 9 yrs. Rainier, Oregon School District.
- ✓ The Absolutely True Diary of a Part Time Indian
  - Book provided to 9<sup>th</sup> Grade English class at Warrenton, Oregon School District
- ✓ Eleanor and Park, by Rainbow Rowell
  - Book provided to Jr. High School students at Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon School District
- ✓ Bless Me Ultima, by Rudolf Anaya
  - Book provided to 9<sup>th</sup> grade students at Scappoose, Oregon School District.

*These books violate the Oregon Department of Education's K-12 Sexuality Education Standard requiring materials and curriculum to be 'Age Appropriate.' In addition, Parental notification is required in advance of ANY instruction on human sexuality or HIV/AIDS, ORS 336.035.*

## OREGON LAW VIOLATES US CONSTITUTION, 1st AMENDMENT and OREGON CONSTITUTION, BILL OF RIGHTS, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 3: Freedom of religious opinion

- ✓ Gay Lesbian Straight Education Network (GLSEN) is invited to schools to advocate for youth homosexual behavior. Encouraging homosexual behavior endangers the health and safety of youth. The U.S. Center for Disease Control (CDC) reports an alarming rise in STDs/STIs, much higher in homosexual males who are more likely to develop HIV infection.
- ✓ GLSEN conducts the Day of Silence, a peer and adult advocacy in solidarity for homosexuality observed in many Oregon schools. 'Safe Schools' and 'Safe Spaces' within schools are part of this advocacy. Endorsing sodomy for minor children, the observance of this political protest indoctrinates and 'grooms' students, violating Informed Consent, Mandatory Reporting, and Age of Consent to Sex Laws. In addition, it violates the Equal Access Act...
- ✓ Oregon government schools require children use alternative terms for gender identity (pronouns) coined by political activists, forcing controversial social/political ideology upon other people's minor children.





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## OREGON VIOLATES IT'S OWN LAWS

1. Age of Consent to Sex, 18 yrs. of age. ORS 167.035 Oregon's K-12
  2. Comprehensive Sexuality Education Standards: Age Appropriate and Medically Accurate. ORS 336.035(2)
  3. Parental notification in advance of any instruction on human sexuality or HIV/AIDS.
- ✓ Making A Difference curriculum encourages early sexual activity; promoting it as normal and acceptable. "No boundaries" sexual experiences such as anal, vaginal, oral, homosexual, heterosexual, touching each other's genitals, and mutual masturbation are touted as simply saying, "I like you."
  - ✓ Making Proud Choices curriculum advocates minors, beginning at 11 yrs. should have fun and pleasurable sex using condoms for vaginal, oral or anal sex.
  - ✓ Planned Parenthood's curriculum, widely used in government schools, provides complete lesson plans for instructing children in sexual orientation and gender identity. A "Genderbread Person" graphic is used to appeal to children as young as 5 yrs.
  - ✓ Teenage students are used in some Oregon schools to teach subjects including contraception, HIV/STD 'prevention', abortion as a safe end to pregnancy, condoms for pleasurable sex, polyamory, and minor sexual rights. These teen 'teachers' are uncertified, unqualified and unaccountable. In Oregon Planned Parenthood Columbia Willamette; PP Great Northwest & Hawaii; and PP Southwest Oregon train at a Peer Education Institute.

**NOTE:** *Every Oregon district School Board has the option of embracing or rejecting specific curriculums/materials, policies, and procedures. However, the Oregon Department of Education applies pressure, citing compliance on Administration and in turn School Board members to implement recommended programs.*
